Would like to see 105% by Campout on June 25th.
2016 goal is 11,570, but would really like to see 12,016
Rewards for the District Commanders and Detachment Vice Commanders will be fishing tackle and a tackle box at the end of the year. District Commanders were given stringers to wear, Detachment Vice Commanders were given nets to wear..
